

SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

Residential

Water: \$7.93 Service Charge and \$9.94 per 1000 gallons.
Sewer: \$5.38 Service Charge and \$22.89 per 1000 gallons.

Commercial

Water: \$7.93 Service Charge and \$12.65 per 1000 gallons.
Sewer: \$5.38 Service Charge and \$28.18 per 1000 gallons.

Industrial

Water: \$7.93 Service Charge and \$14.36 per 1000 gallons.

Water Tap Fees:

¾ inch	\$ 1,500.00
1 inch	\$ 2,000.00
2 inch	\$ 4,000.00
3 inch and up	To be determined

Residential Sewer Tap Fee: \$ 1,700.00

Note: The cost of upgrade from one tap size to another will be the cost of the respective taps as stated above. Churches and community clubs will be charged the actual cost of installation of the tap in lieu of the full tap fee. This is a community service provided by the Department.

Should the cost of the installation of the tap exceed the tap fee, the additional cost will be borne by the customer.

0-50 Lots	\$225.00 each subdivision
51-100 Lots	\$250.00 each subdivision

Commercial Sites: 1 Lot = 1 acre parcel (minimum \$150.00 fee)

*Water Theft will result in the Metro Utility Department pressing legal charges against the customer with the Moore County Sheriff’s Department for all occurrences with no exceptions.

Water Rates for Filling Swimming Pools

Water and Sewer Adjustments

Filling swimming pools by a customer will not accrue a sewer charge for water used to fill the pool if the customer notifies the office in advance of filling the pool. The customer’s meter is to be read before and after filling. The charge for reading the meter is \$20.00. The sewer charge will then be adjusted accordingly, and the customer charged for only water used in filling the swimming pool.
